

THE NPS/ROSETTES DIRECT HOME PRODUCED RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

This championship is for Home Produced ridden stallions, mares and geldings. Ponies which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1st January in the current year have not been shown by a producer or stabled in a producer's yard other than on a DIY basis or at stud. Ponies shown in these classes must be produced and shown by the owner/spouse or his/her son/daughter/grandchild, who does not derive income from working with ponies or horses. Please enter this class in the spirit it is intended. Competitors who contravene the above will be disqualified.

Qualifying rounds for this competition are run in conjunction with other NPS open ridden classes. Riders of eligible ponies must wear a white arm band to indicate their Home Produced status.

PRIZES: Rosettes 1 - 6 in all classes plus Champion & Reserve Rosettes.

RULES: (To be read with the NPS Rules for Showing)

The Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any Class with less than 3 entries at the closing date, sub-divide any class or withdraw any prize money.

Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the class being judged, accompanied by £10.00. Deposit returnable if the objection is upheld.

The Committee will not be responsible for any accident to animals, persons or property.

The decisions of the Judges and Committee are final.

It is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter their ponies in the correct class or classes.

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full fees.

No Ponies may be plaited in M & M Classes.

Correctly secured British Standard skull caps/riding hats BS 4472 or BS 6473 or PAS 015 must be worn at all times when mounted.

No loose dogs allowed on the showground.

In all ridden classes the wearing of SPURS is forbidden.

Show canes/whips must not exceed 30".

Children must be three years old before competing in any ridden class.

All ponies entered in M & M classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books and registration numbers must be stated on the entry form and with entries on the day.

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: Judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition. The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the Final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the Final.

NPS MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND KILMANNAN STUD SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE CHAMPIONSHIP

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by The National Pony Society for the best registered pony in the Mountain & Moorland In-Hand Section. To be judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, or the Owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 4-6th August 2010.

NPS BRITISH ISLES AREA IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP.

The winning pony from each of the in hand classes held at the show is eligible to go forward to this championship. The Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion ponies at each Area show qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship show. If the Supreme and/or Reserve Supreme has already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

The owner need not be an NPS member for the pony/horse to enter this competition or to qualify for the final but will have to become a Showing member to enter the final. There are no specific registration criteria for ponies.

CLASS 7. NPS/MICOR DEMOLITION LTD M&M LEADING REIN CHAMPIONSHIP.

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 122 cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in one of the snaffle bridles illustrated in the NPS Rule Book.

CLASS 8. NPS/MICOR DEMOLITION LTD M&M FIRST RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP.

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128 cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Ponies never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in Leading Rein classes or qualified for the NPS/Micor Demolition M&M Leading Rein Final before 1st January in current year. To be shown in one of the snaffle bridles illustrated in the NPS Rule Book.

CLASS 12. NPS / SIMPSON REFRACTORIES M&M NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

To be judged under the rules of the NPS. Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B, mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128 cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in First Ridden classes or qualified for the NPS/Micor Demolition M&M First Ridden Final before 1st January in current year.

TINY TOTS Championship 1st & 2nd from classes 7-8 & 11-12 to compete

NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, or the Owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. NPS / HAWKINS SMITH NATIVES BRITISH ISLES AREA SUPREME RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP. The winning pony / horse from each of the ridden classes or championships held at the Show is eligible to go forward to this championship. The Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion ponies at each Area show qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship show. If the Supreme and/or Reserve Supreme has already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

The owner need not be an NPS member for the pony/horse to enter this competition or to qualify for the final but will have to become a Showing member to enter the final. There are no specific registration criteria for ponies.

NPS/PICTON M&M NOVICE RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP.

Open to pure bred registered Mountain and Moorland stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over. A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

Won an open NPS affiliated M&M Ridden class

Won a class at an Olympia, HOYS or RIHS qualifying round

Qualified for HOYS or RIHS

Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show

Qualified for the M&M Ridden Championship final at Olympia in previous years or in the current year

CLASS 18. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A stallion, mare or gelding 4 & over.

CLASS 19. Welsh B, Welsh C stallion, mare or gelding, four years old or over.

CLASS 20. New Forest, Connemara stallion, mare or gelding four years old or over.

CLASS 21. Fell, Highland, Dales, stallion, mare or gelding four years old and over

CLASS 22. Welsh D stallion, mare or gelding four years old and over

NPS/R H R DEMOLITION MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND JUNIOR RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TO BE RUN UNDER NPS RULES

CLASS 23. Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A, Welsh Section B mares and geldings four years old and over. Riders must not have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 24. Open to registered Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Connemara and Welsh Section C mares and geldings four years old and over, not exceeding 138 cm. Riders must not have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 25. Open to registered Dales Fell, Highland, New Forest, Connemara and Welsh Section D, mares and geldings four years old and over, exceeding 138 cm but not exceeding 148cms (except for Welsh Section D and Dales). Riders must not have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

CLASS 37. NPS/HIRSTMUND STUD M&M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – small breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B. Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden Mountain & Moorland Class prior to the commencement of the current Winter Series. All ponies in this class must be shown in one of the snaffle bridles illustrated in the NPS 2009 Official Rule Book. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

CLASS 38. NPS/HIRSTMUND STUD M&M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – large breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden Mountain & Moorland Class prior to the commencement of the current Winter Series. All ponies in this class must be shown in one of the snaffle bridles illustrated in the NPS 2009 Official Rule Book. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

CLASS 39. NPS/FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP small breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class. Ponies are to be shown in any suitable bridle. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

CLASS 40. NPS/FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – large breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class. Ponies are to be shown in any suitable bridle. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).
