To be held at The Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead, West Sussex RH17 5NU in July 2017

Owners must be Annual Members /Riders must be current P(UK) Annual/Senior/Junior Riders Club Members and the Ponies currently registered with P(UK) before time of entry in order to compete in these classes. Open to Mountain and Moorland Ridden Stallion (Intermediate class only), Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D. The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will receive notification of their qualification for the RIHS Young Riders M&M Ridden and the highest placed pony and rider not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the final.

Class 67 – P(UK) Intermediate M&M – Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society stud books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Section A, B, C or D. Rider not to have attained their 25th Birthday before the 1st January in the current year. (See Rule 7 of the current P(UK) Rule Book).

RULES:

Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS.

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply.

For Summer Championship qualifiers the highest placed pony, owned by an NPS member, in each class goes forward to the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification goes no lower than third place.

Riders of small breed stallions must be 12 years or over, riders of large breed stallions must be 14 years or over

The Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any Class with less than 3 entries or sub-divide any class.

Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the class being judged, accompanied by £20.00. Deposit returnable if the objection is upheld.

The Committee will not be responsible for any accident to animals, persons or property.

The decisions of the Judges and Committee are final. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter their ponies in the correct class or classes.

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full fees.

No Ponies may be plaited in M & M Classes.

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards MUST

be worn by all Riders. All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.

All children 14 years and under must wear HARD HATS when showing in-hand.

No loose dogs allowed on the showground/arenas.

In all ridden classes the wearing of SPURS is forbidden.

Show canes/whips must not exceed 30".

Children must be three years old before competing in any ridden class.

All ponies entered in M & M classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books. This also applies to horses/ponies entered as partbred M&M. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form and with entries on the day.

To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB. All stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker available from the NPS office.

The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter these classes but only ponies owned by NPS Qualifying or Life members can qualify for the final. Membership cards must be shown. Qualification to go no lower than third place.

The 1st & 2nd prizewinners from each of classes 34-39 will qualify for a semi-final to be held at the Blue Chip Native BSPS Heritage Championship Show, at Arena UK. (The qualification will NOT pass down the line). These classes are also qualifiers for the BSPS Classic Security UK Ltd Challenge, BSPS Premier League, BSPS Premier League and BSPS Industrial Salt Supplies WOW Factor.

(PUK) qualifiers THE 1ST 2ND & 3RD IN EACH QUALIFYING CLASS WILL QUALIFY. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring and placings will be confirmed by results sent in by the show secretary.
