This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 122cms. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 9th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

10. NPS/SHOWING CLASSICS M&M FIRST RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book.

Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 128cms.

Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 12th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

i. Won an open NPS affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class

ii. Won a Ridden class at an Olympia, Horse of the Year Show or RIHS qualifying round

iii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS Ridden classes

iv. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).

v. Qualified for the M&M Ridden Championship final at Olympia in previous years

vi. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.

Mares and geldings four years old and over not exceeding 122 cms, registered in the main body of the following Breed Society stud books: Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh A and Welsh B. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday by the 1st January in the current year.

35. NPS M&M NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER).

Mares and geldings four years old and over not exceeding 128cms, registered in the main body of the following Breed Society stud books: Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh A and Welsh B. The pony never to have won a first prize of £5 or more in any First Ridden Mountain & Moorland classes or qualified for the NPS M&M First Ridden final before 1st January in the current year. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the NPS / The Minns Family M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in Malvern. Membership card to be shown in the ring.

Sashes to the Champion and Reserve. Sash to the highest placed NPS Area 25 Member

PRIZES: Rosettes 1 - 6 in all classes plus Champion & Reserve Sashes.

RULES:

Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS.

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply.

For Summer Championship qualifiers the highest placed pony, owned by an NPS member, in each class goes forward to the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification goes no lower than third place.

Riders of small breed stallions must be 12 years or over, riders of large breed stallions must be 14 years or over

The Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any Class with less than 3 entries or sub-divide any class.

Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the class being judged, accompanied by £20.00. Deposit returnable if the objection is upheld.

The Committee will not be responsible for any accident to animals, persons or property.

The decisions of the Judges and Committee are final.

It is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter their ponies in the correct class or classes.

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full fees.

No Ponies may be plaited in M & M Classes.

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards MUST be worn by all Riders. All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.

All children 14 years and under must wear HARD HATS when showing in-hand.

No loose dogs allowed on the showground/arenas.

In all ridden classes the wearing of SPURS is forbidden.

Show canes/whips must not exceed 30".

Children must be three years old before competing in any ridden class.

All ponies entered in M & M classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books. This also applies to horses/ponies entered as partbred M&M. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form and with entries on the day.

To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

All stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker available from the NPS office.
